ABOUT US

Fourth & Hope is located in Woodland, CA. We provide homeless services, treatment, and housing for residents of Yolo County.

We have been the constant in our community for 38 years. With the help of supporters like you, we have moved thousands of people from the streets to stability. Learn more at fourthandhope.org.



OUR PROGRAMS

SHELTER SERVICES

We operate a 100-bed emergency shelter 365 days a year for men and women. Services include three meals daily, restrooms, showers, laundry, phone, mail, and case management. Dinner is open to anyone in need of a hot meal. Last year 280 people received overnight services, 66 people moved into housing, 234 people received street outreach/day services, and 93,000 meals were served.

TREATMENT

Certified by Medi-Cal and accredited by CARF, our substance use disorder treatment program, Walters House, offers assessments, treatment and aftercare plans, education, and crisis intervention for up to 44 residential clients. Group and individual sessions are offered for both our residential and outpatient clients. Last year 304 people received services.

HOUSING

Housing is comprised of two programs that include case management: Transitional/Sober Living and Permanent Supportive Housing. Last year 147 men, women, and children received services.
