



# **ABOUT** US



Fourth & Hope is a faith-based nonprofit in Woodland, CA, guiding individuals from crisis to stability. For over 40 years, we've served Yolo County residents facing homelessness, hunger, and mental health or substance use challenges —with compassion at our core.

Our services span key locations, including the Community of Hope campus in East Beamer and Bridge Housing programs on 4th Street for men, women, and families.

## OUR **PROGRAMS**

### NAVIGATION CENTER—SHELTER SERVICES

A vital entry point for individuals experiencing homelessness. Our 100-bed facility operates as Yolo County's primary Navigation Center, providing emergency shelter while connecting individuals to long-term solutions. Open 365 days a year, it offers more than a place to sleep—it is a gateway to stability. Clients receive nutritious meals, safe rest, and direct access to case management, behavioral health support, and referrals to specialized programs across the county. Our team works to identify root causes and connect each person with the right resources—whether that's treatment, housing, or healthcare.

#### TREATMENT—WALTER'S HOUSE

Walter's House is our 60-bed residential substance use treatment program, providing structured recovery for men and women. The facility offers clinical assessments, individual and group therapy, family services, crisis intervention, and aftercare planning. Accredited by CARF and certified by Medi-Cal, it is a cornerstone of our continuum of care. Last year, 304 people received treatment through our residential and outpatient programs.

### **HOUSING & RECOVERY SUPPORT**

Our housing programs offer critical stepping stones for individuals and families on their path to independence. This includes transitional housing, permanent supportive housing, and a specialized 24-bed Behavioral Health Bridge **Housing** program for women. Each model offers safe, short-term or long-term housing, along with individualized case management and supportive services tailored to meet the needs of each resident. Last year, 147 people—men, women, and families—found stability through these programs.
